International Center for Korean Studies of Moscow State University invites you to attend its **7th International Conference of Young Scholars on Korean Studies on June 23–24, 2023**, which will be hosted by Institute of Asian and African Countries of Moscow State University.

The conference will be held in a hybrid format (in person / online).

The conference will cover a wide range of topics on Korean Studies in the following subject areas: **Political Studies, Economy, History, Philology, and Culture**. The conference aims to give graduate students in all Korea-related fields an opportunity to present their research, share academic interests, and strengthen ties with other junior scholars.

Eligible Applicants: MA students, PhD students, and post-docs who have received their PhD in 2022 – first half of 2023, from Russia, CIS countries, Europe, and Republic of Korea. The conference is open not only to representatives of universities, but also to the young scholars, working in public and private sector, and to other specialists involved in the Korean studies. Age – under 35.

Languages: Russian and English.

Abstracts (500-700 words) must contain a list of references and sources. Abstracts and references are attached in one file in MS Word or RTF format (file name = Full name, for example, SmithJohn.docx).

Deadline for proposals is **May 10, 2023**. A special committee will select materials. Notification of acceptance will be sent by May 17, 2023.

The publication of abstracts is not expected. The most interesting papers may be published in the “Russian Korean Studies Herald” as separate articles.

The organizers do not provide accommodation and reimbursement of transportation costs for non-resident and foreign participants.
